

June 17 & 18, 2017: The Good Samaritan

Bible Passage: Luke 10:25-37

Main Point: Jesus calls us to love others as He has loved us.

Key Passage: *When Jesus ... saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things.*

Big Picture Question: Why did Jesus tell parables? Jesus told parables to teach people about God and His kingdom.

Day 1: READ -> Luke 10:25-37

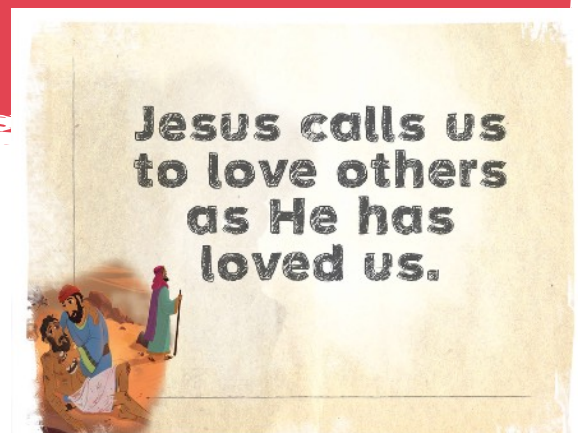
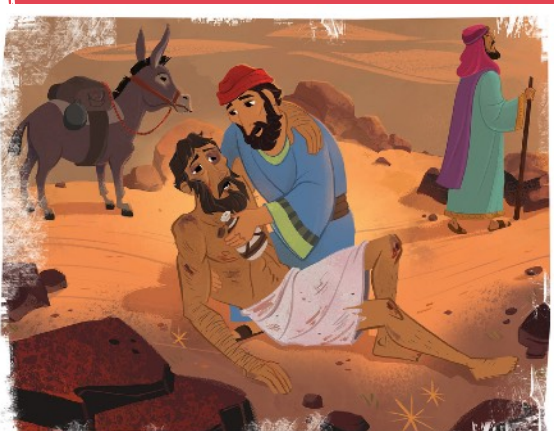
THINK -> How has Jesus shown us love? How can we show love to others?

PRAY -> Thank God for His love for us! Thank God for sending Jesus for us.
Ask God to help you to love others

Day 2: READ -> Luke 10:25 & Luke 10:29

THINK -> What questions did the expert ask Jesus? How did Jesus answer him?

PRAY -> Ask God to help you to be prepared to answer when someone asks you about God.



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Day 3: FAMILY ACTIVITY -> As a family, choose a nation or people group that is different from you. Learn some details about where they live, and what life is like there.
Write what you learned here:

PRAY -> Commit to praying for the people/nation that you chose. Remember that Samaritans were disliked by the Jews because they were foreigners. The story of the Good Samaritan shows that anyone can be a good neighbor.
