September 30 & October 1, 2017: Jesus' Crucifixion

Bible Passage: Matthew 27:11-66

Main Point: Jesus was crucified on the cross.

Key Passage: *It is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast.* Ephesians 2:8-9

Big Picture Question: Why did Jesus die on the cross? Jesus died on the cross to save us from our sins and came back to life to show we are forgiven.

Day 1: READ -> Matthew 27:11-31

THINK -> Why were the people so angry about Jesus?

PRAY -> Thank God for Jesus! Through His death, God shows us that He takes sin seriously *and* that He loves us so much! Thank God for His love for you.

Ephesians 2:8-9



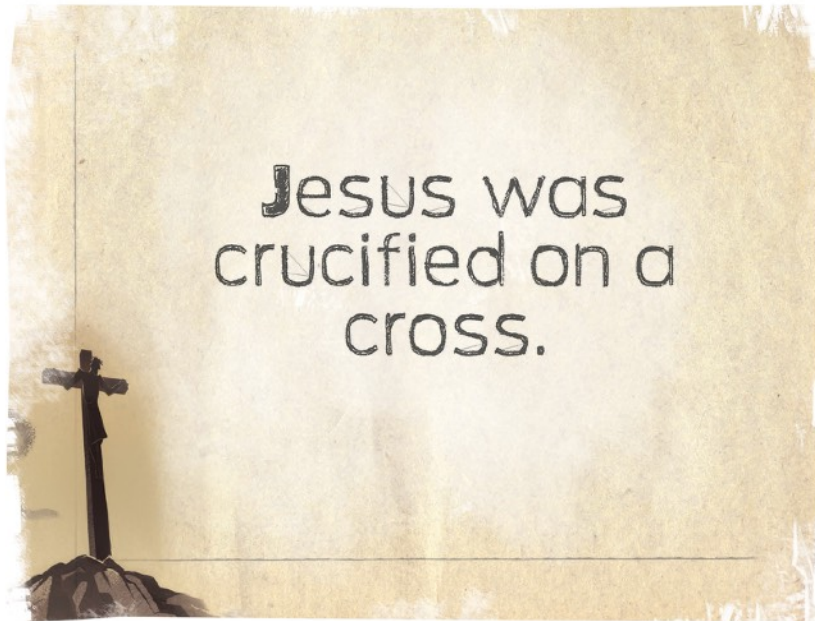

Day 2: READ -> Matthew 27:32-56

THINK -> Why is Jesus' death so important?

PRAY -> Thank God for the cross. This seems like a strange thing to thank God for, but it is because of the cross that we can be free from sin. The cross was a tool that the Romans used to humiliate and to kill, but it brings us life through Jesus!



Day 3: READ -> Matthew 27:57-66

THINK -> Who can be saved through Jesus' sacrifice?

PRAY -> Think of people in your life who may not know what Jesus did for them. Ask God to give you opportunities to share the love of Jesus with those people! Then, be on the lookout for those opportunities, and be ready to share.
