October 7 & 8, 2017: Jesus' Resurrection

Bible Passage: Matthew 28:1-15; John 20:1-18

Main Point: Jesus was resurrected on the third day.

Key Passage: *It is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast.* Ephesians 2:8-9

Big Picture Question: Why did Jesus die on the cross? Jesus died on the cross to save us from our sins and came back to life to show we are forgiven.

Day 1: READ -> Matthew 28:1-15

THINK -> Why is Jesus' resurrection so important?

PRAY -> Jesus keeps His promises! He said that He would rise again on the third day, and He did that. Thank God that He keeps His promises to us.

Ephesians 2:8-9



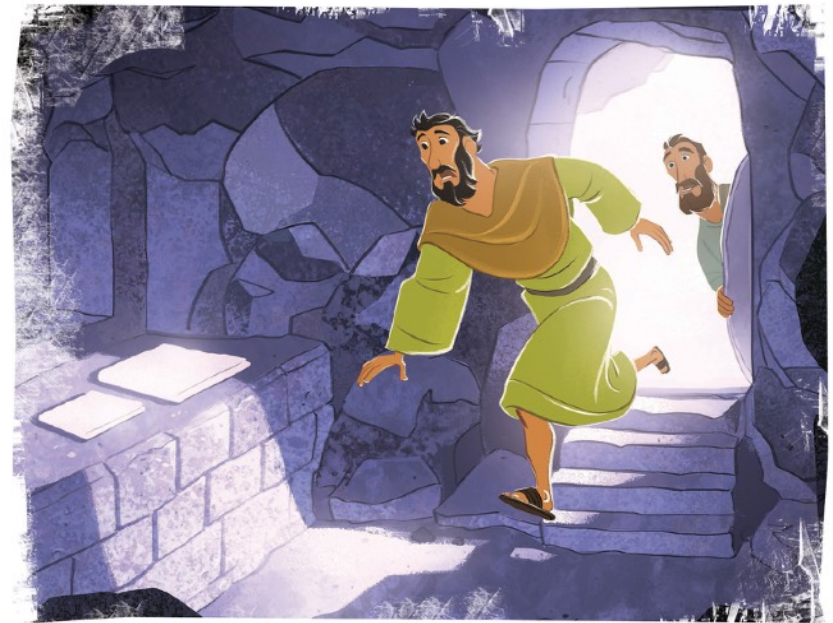

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Day 2: READ -> John 20:1-18

THINK -> Why do you think the disciples didn't understand that Jesus had to rise from the dead? (John 20:9)

PRAY -> Think about things that you can't see but you know are there (the wind, magnetism, static electricity.). Right now, we can't see Jesus next to us, but He is very much alive and real. Ask God to help you to believe in Him, to trust that Jesus is who He says He is!



Day 3: READ -> 1 Corinthians 15:3-8

THINK -> Who does Paul list that Jesus appeared to in these verses? Why do you think Paul lists so many people?

PRAY -> Thank God that Jesus is alive! He appeared to many people and proved that He is alive. We can have hope because Jesus is alive today.
