February 10 & 11, 2018: Paul's Second Journey

Bible Passage: Acts 16:11-34

Main Point: Paul and Silas told the jailer, "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved."

Key Passage: *You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.* Acts 1:8

Big Picture Question: How do people hear about Jesus? God uses Christians to tell others about Jesus so they may repent and be saved.

Day 1: READ -> Acts 16:11-18

THINK ->

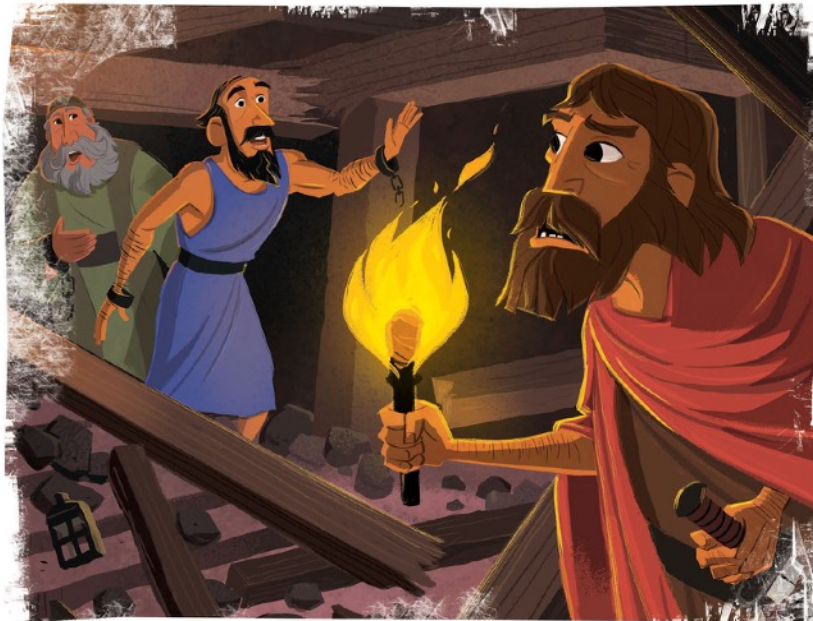
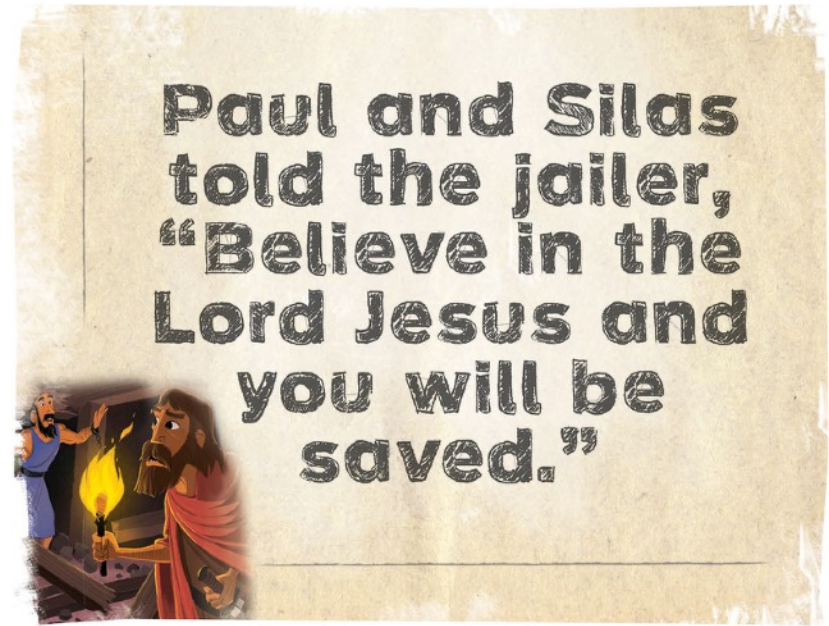

Day 2: **READ** -> Acts 16:19-34

THINK -> What did Paul and Silas do in jail?

Day 3: **MAKE A LIST** -> Paul and Silas had been beaten and put in prison. But they could pray! List some things that you can praise God for, no matter how bad things seem to be. Put a copy of your list where you can see it every day.
