**March 3 & 4, 2018: Paul Confronted Peter**

**Bible Passage:** Galatians 2:11-21

**Main Point:** Paul wrote that we are saved through faith in Jesus alone.

**Key Passage:** *I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.* Galatians 2:20

**Big Picture Question:** Why does God want us to obey Him? Obedience is our response to God's love for us.

**Day 1: READ ->** Galatians 2:11-16

**THINK ->** Why was it wrong for Peter to avoid eating with Gentile believers?

**THINK ->** Why is it important to know that faith in Jesus is the only thing that saves us?



