April 14 & 15, 2018: Paul's Letters to Church Leaders

Bible Passage: 1 Timothy 4:11-16; 2 Timothy 4:1-8;
Titus 2:11-14

Main Point: Paul encouraged church leaders to teach God's Word.


Key Passage: *I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.* Galatians 2:20

Big Picture Question: Why does God want us to obey Him? Obedience is our response to God's love for us.

Day 1: READ -> 1 Timothy 4:11-16

THINK -> What things does Paul tell Timothy to do in these verses?

PRAY -> Ask God to help you to set an example for others in the things that you say and in how you live. Thank God for the promise of the Holy Spirit to guide you!

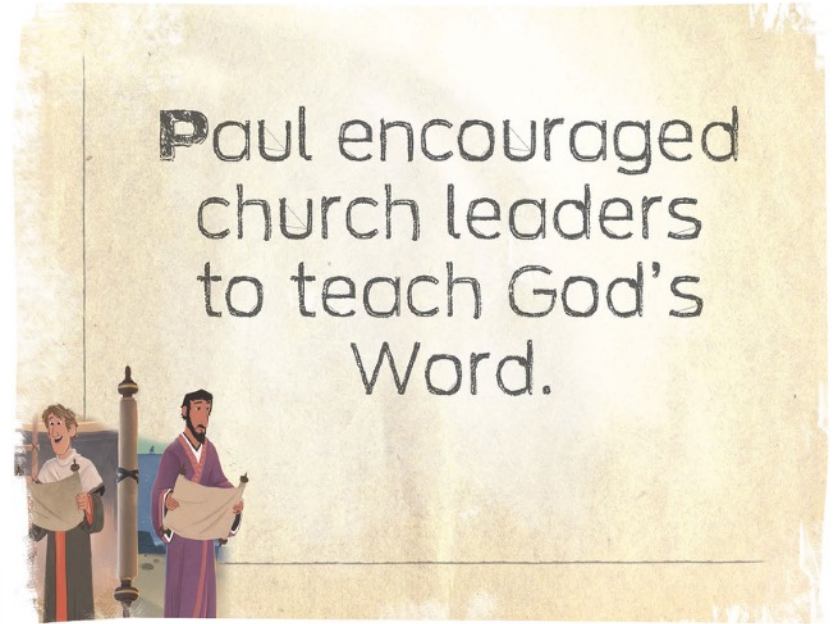
