July 7 & 8, 2018: Paul's Letter to Philemon

Bible Passage: Philemon 8-22

Main Point: Paul told Philemon to forgive his servant as a Christian brother.

Key Passage: *All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.* 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Big Picture Question: How do we live while waiting for Jesus to return? We remember God's truth, grow in godliness, and spread the gospel.

Day 1: READ -> Philemon 8-22

THINK -> How did Paul feel about Onesimus? What was he asking Philemon to do?

PRAY -> Thank God that because of what He has done for us through Jesus, we have an eternal family! Even though you may not have any earthly brothers or sisters, you can be part of God's family, and have many brothers and sisters!

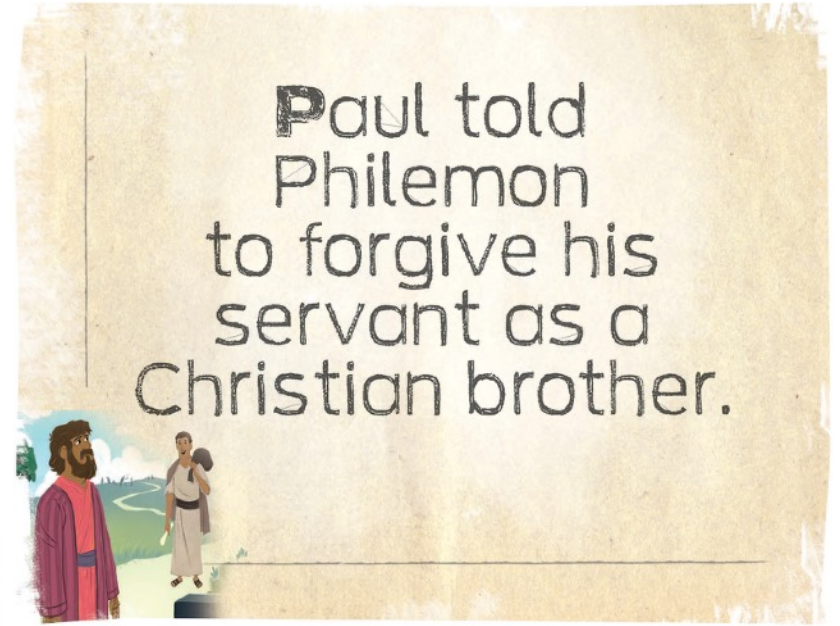
